

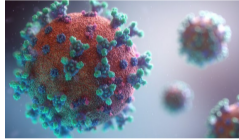

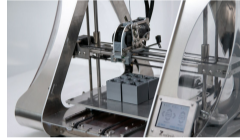


### Impact of COVID-19 on Terrorism
