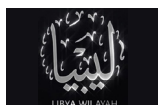


Selected Logos of Foreign Terrorist Organizations

The following logos are commonly associated with groups designated as foreign terrorist organizations (including their subsidiaries) by the Secretary of State under section 219(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA). These emblems have been found on documents, jewelry, posters, media releases, and other materials, and displaying them may indicate membership or financial or general support. This graphic updates information published in June 2023 by revising logos for the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia–Segunda Marquetalia (FARC-SM), New Irish Republican Army (formerly Real IRA), and Shining Path (SL), and adding a logo for Jemaah Islamiyah (JI).

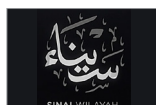
